

Six of the state's top medical research institutions are members of the Texas Alzheimer's Research and Care Consortium (TARCC). They are:

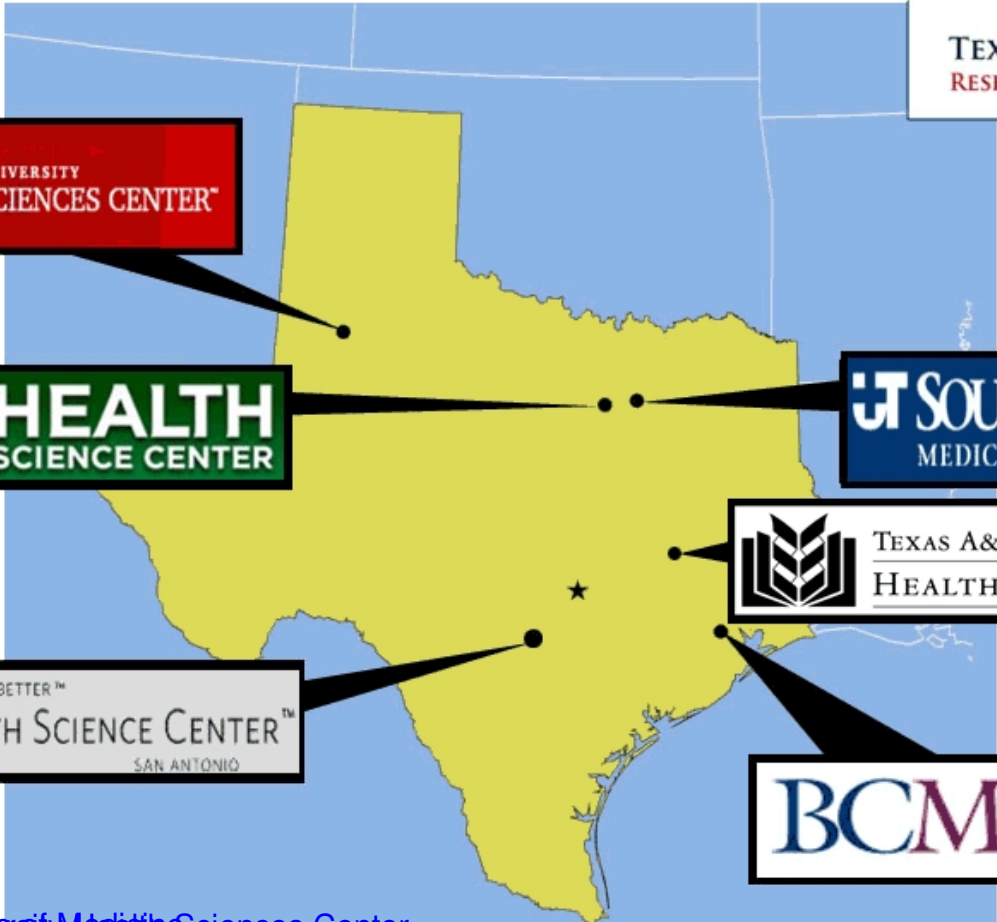
